The Southlake Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce that it will once again award two \$1,000 scholarships to two Carroll Senior High School graduating seniors. These scholarship funds are awarded to aid graduates in their pursuit of higher education.

The criteria are based on the student's academic accomplishments (30%), extracurricular activities (20%), and essay portion (50%). Additionally, they are only available to qualifying Carroll Senior High School graduates who enroll in an accredited college or university for the fall semester of the current year.


The Chamber's scholarship task force will review each qualifying application within a few days after the application deadline. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the awards assembly in May.

To apply:

1. Complete the confidential information sheet.
2. Return the confidential information sheet to your counselor.
3. Complete the scholarship application, making sure that your name *does not* appear anywhere on the application, transcript, or letters of recommendation.
